To Customers of Pleiger Plastics:

This letter is provided for your convenience in answering questions or inquiries regarding our product's compliance with RoHS and Reach.

RoHS regulations generally do not apply to finish molded components, and only apply to substances that become part of the finished product or its packaging. Despite this, there are frequent inquiries about our compliance, and this document, with the following information, may be used to furnish your customers with a statement of compliance of our products:

All of our Plei-Tech polyurethane compounds manufactured by Plastics Company, per the information provided by our raw material suppliers, and to the best of our knowledge, are not manufactured with and do not contain any elements listed on the EU SVHC 161 list, including lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls or polybrominated diphenyls ethers, cadmium, DEHP, BBP, DBP or DIBP. None of these elements or compounds are used in any of Pleiger Plastics Company manufacturing process, or the shipping containers for those products.

REACH regulations do cover molded products but only where SVHCs are not chemically reacted into the product and are intended to release over time as a function of the article. All of Pleiger Plastics parts are articles which are not intended to release a chemical substance, and as such are not subject to the registration requirements.
